

Entrants for the Hong Kong MAKE Award 2010 are bound by the terms and conditions of the Award. Please read carefully the following terms. Failure to comply may lead to rejection or disqualification of the entry.

Terms and conditions

1. The entrant's name (i.e. the name of the organisation) stated in the application form will be displayed in all announcements, promotion and collateral materials associated with the HK MAKE Award 2010.
2. The entrant is required to enter the Business Registration number when lodging their application and may be further asked to submit the Business Registration document for verification.
3. Separate applications submitted by the entrants of different business groups or units under the same organisation will be accepted. However, only one award will be presented to the organisation of the entrants even if more than one business group or unit won the Award.
4. The entrant must ensure the report, including all design and work submitted, does not infringe the intellectual property rights of any third party. The organiser will not be responsible for any such infringements in whatsoever and entrants found to have committed intellectual property right infringements will be disqualified immediately. Application fee will NOT be refunded.
5. The entrant is required to sign the non-disclosure agreement provided by the organiser. Organiser will not accept any non-disclosure agreement which is provided by the entrant.
6. The entrant must adhere to the schedule and submit their report on time. Late submission will not be considered.
7. All information, including the logo of the organisation, will be used by the organiser strictly for purposes related to the Award. These information may be disclosed and transfer thereof to the organiser's employees, officers, legal advisors, or judging panel of the Award on a need-to-know basis and only to the extent necessary for each of them to perform his duties.
8. An awardee agrees to allow the organiser to use its organisation logo in the promotion and publicity materials of the Award.
9. The entrant agrees not to make any claim or bring any action against the organiser and members of the Judging Panel for any reason whatsoever, or otherwise seek to recover from the organiser and members of the Judging Panel, any costs incurred in relation to the Award or any lost expectation of profits or any other benefits which the entrant may expect to accrue from participating in the Award.
10. An entered application cannot be withdrawn once the assessment process has commenced.
11. The terms and conditions are subject to change by the organiser when necessary. The organiser reserves the right to revise the rules of the Award without prior announcement.
12. The application of the HK MAKE Award and Outstanding KM Project award is mutually exclusive
